It is hoped that the people of India in 2029 would exercise their wisdom to show the gate to the dictator like Modi not only for their safety and security but for the future of their children.

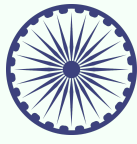

On 06 July, 2023, a telephone call from Baldev Raj Bhardwaj, our respected brother-in-law, made a thundering jolt to my body. He told, "Papaji is no more". He also told that the dead body was taken to the mortuary since my brother, sister from Canada had to reach to see the face of our beloved, respected father for the last time. For a moment it was unbelievable news. I told my wife and children. They started crying along with me. Immediately, I requested my best friend to drop me in Jalandhar since I was not in a position to travel alone. He came to my home and drove me from Delhi to Jalandhar. We are thankful to all Ambedkarites and Buddhists who stood by us in this critical time. They consoled us. They helped us in organizing funeral and the last rites.

Our beloved father (1930-2023) departed finally, living us in sorrow, pain & grief permanently. Not a single thing or person can replace him. Whenever I happen to go to Jalandhar in connection with Ambedkar Bhawan Trust meeting or some other important social function in Jalandhar, I sleep on the same bed where my father used to sleep. I feel the fragrance of my father`s body around the bed and feel as if he is in my body and mind. One side of the bed was always full of volumes of Baba Saheb Dr. Ambedkar Writings and Speeches. He subscribed to 10 national dailies including Mainstream and Outlook magazine. He was influenced by Mohammed Iqbal & Faiz Ahmed Faiz poetry and often used in his books.

Most of the time, I cannot sleep as I always feel that he is still there. I go to his big library and sit on the same chair on which he used to sit, write, I feel his physical presence. I go through the books. I find the books he read are well -marked for ready reference. In his suitcase, his favorite cap (some sort of Lenin cap) is lying. He told me he bought it from England for the first time. Later on, his close friends in the Ambedkar mission started bringing this type of cap for him from England, Canada & USA as a gesture of love. He had 10-12 caps. He was a simple, honest man. He was a voracious reader. Books were his friends. Books on Ambedkarism including Baba Saheb Dr Ambedkar Writing & Speech volumes, Buddhism, Shaheed Bhagat Singh, Gandhi, Jawaharlal Nehru, Sardar Patel, Lenin, Marx, Tolstoy, Bertrand Russell, Sat Guru Ravidass, Mohammed Iqbal, Faiz Ahmed Faiz, Gurdas Ram Alam including Bhagwat Gita, Quran are still lying on the shelves in his library. He knew Hindi, Punjabi, English, Urdu & Persian.

Respected mother late Ajit Kaur Balley stood by my father through thick and thin. My father had immense love for my mother. They were compatible companions. Our mother was a pious lady who not only took care of children but also participated in social, political activities of Republican Party of India (RPI). Three daughters namely Shakuntla Nagar, Sunita Bhardwaj and Sujata Sallan equally contributed to social, political life of father.

Out of love, my brother Anand Kumar Balley and My sister Sujata Sallan and her husband Mohinder Sallan used to bring shirts, warm jackets, socks for him from Canada. My elder sister Shakuntla Nagar and Sunita Bhardwaj also used to bring gifts on Father`s Day.

Our father faced tremendous hardships and struggles. Our father was a fearless leader. He was a fiery orator. He was an intelligent revolutionary. He lived dangerously. He survived by a bullet during the Talhan village agitation where a Dalit woman was raped by a Jat Sikh. He was always ready to help socially oppressed and improvised people. He was a proponent of pro-working-class measures and opponent of monopoly practices. He was a brilliant skilled & disciplined strategist & organizer. He was peerless in his public dealings. He detested betrayal uncompromisingly. He made a brief foray in state politics but unsuccessful. He never dithered despite physical risk.

His inspired people. He built a strong team through his vision and integrity of character. He was dedicated, honest to the cause of the Ambedkar Mission. He wrote more than 200 books. Preferably, he used to publish pamphlets, the idea behind was to offer quick reading. He was one of the authors who formidably and fiercely wrote against the wickedness of Brahmanism. As Baba Saheb Dr Ambedkar said, "I hate injustice, tyranny, pompousness' and humbug, and my hatred embraces all those who are guilty of them. I want to tell my critics that I regard my feelings of hatred as a real force." This is what our father believed and practiced.

In his thoughtful book: Leadership: Six Studies in World Strategy, the late Henry Kissinger, President of USA wrote, the price of making history.



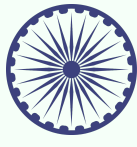

I remember people from distant areas of Punjab used to visit him for seeking advice on social, religious and political issues. He had extraordinary charisma. He earned sobriquet as "Lion of Punjab".

He played an active role along with others in establishing exemplary institution like Ambedkar Bhawan in Jalandhar. People of Punjab are emotionally attached to this place as Baba Saheb Dr. B.R. Ambedkar visited this piece of land in 1951, later on bought by father. Our beloved father was a practicing Buddhist.

This memorial would be incomplete if I do not mention contributions of B.R. Bhardwaj. In our absence, Bhardwaj took care of our father. He stood by our father day and night. He used to shave, change his clothes sometimes. During illness, Bhardwaj never left our father alone. We are grateful to him. We are also grateful to Nirmal Binge for taking care of our father. Dr. Charanjit Singh, brother of BR Bhardwaj was always available on phone call if any medicine or injection was required in case of illness. We are indebted to him. Blood pressure and sugar level of our father was monitored on a regular basis by our cousin Kamalsheel. We are thankful to him.

In the last days, I had lot of discussion with him in regard to continuation of Bheem Patrika and Bheem Patrika Publications. One day he said to me, "you are a qualified; you should continue it". He was quite confident that I am capable to run Bheem Patrika so I started digital version in the month of October, 2023 and regularly publishing it with the support of B. R. Bhardwaj, my brother Anand Kumar Balley from Canada. We as his children are proud of our great father who fulfilled his promise given to Baba Saheb Dr. B. R. Ambedkar carried forward the Caravan.

He was intellectual giant. Our father was a friend, philosopher to all of us. He was a Hero and would remain a Hero to all of us. Papa Ji, we cannot forget you. We are also sure that the people who knew you and your contributions & accomplishments to Ambedkar Mission and literature would keep your name alive in the minds of the coming generations.

### SOHAN LAL SAMPLA

**Sohan Lal Sampla**, a true **Ambedkrite** and **Buddhist** migrated to Britian in 1974 and lived in Bedford till 1975 before permanently migrating to German in 1984. In his stay at Bedford, United Kingdom, he met Chanan Chahal, Rattan Lal Sampla. Chanan Chahal was working in the Federation of Ambedkarite and Buddhist organisations (FABO) and spreading the message of Baba Saheb Dr. with other prominent Ambedkarites & Buddhists in the United Kingdom.

Before migrating to United Kingdom, Sohan Lal Sampla, Bodh Raj Sampla, Prakash Sampla along with other 51 active members of Republican Party of India(RPI) participated in 1964 agitation. Sohan Lal Sampla went with others to Delhi to protest in front of Prime Minister of India (Lal Bahadur Shastri) house. The agitation from Punjab was led by renowned, respected, mentor Lahori Ram Balley, general secretary of Republican Party of India (RPI). More than three Lakhs RPI workers were arrested. I recall, all RPI worker chanted in one tone 'Jai Bheem, Dr. Ambedkar Jindabad' in the jail.

The Prime Minister accepted the demands of the RPI. Due to this agitation, land was distributed among landless Dalits in Punjab which was one of the agenda of the agitation. It is informed to the readers that there were 03 MLAs. Ministers were there from the RPI quota.

There is misperception that the people of India came to know about Baba Saheb Dr. B.R. Ambedkar after 1984. This is totally untrue. This type of mischievous propaganda is spread by politically unsuccessful, highly selfish, greedy leaders from one Dalit party who are neither true Ambedkarite nor Buddhist.

**Lahori Ram Balley** reproduced the literature of **Baba Saheb Dr. Ambedkar** through Bheem Patrika Publications, Jalandhar which was established in 1958. The literature helped in spreading the name of Baba Saheb Dr. Ambedkar from Punjab to various states of India.

Balley also went to England, Canada, USA, Taiwan, and many more countries and spread the name of Dr. Ambedkar. Balley published "Annihilation of Caste" in English, Urdu, Punjabi, Hindi. This book opened the eyes of the world about the prevailing Caste System in India. Balley Published more than 200 books in different languages.

In 2023 & 2024, Dr. Ambedkar Birth Day was celebrated by the team members.

**Sohan Lal Sampla** has been quite active in German in promoting Baba Saheb Dr. Ambedkar literature. The book 'Dr. Ambedkar Life and Mission' written in English by Lahori Ram Balley is translated into German language by Dr. Ambedkar Mission Society Europe. The team of the society is distributing this translated book to various German Universities, professors and students. It is a great achievement.

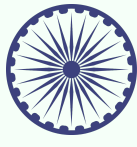

न्यायमूर्ति पी.वी. कुन्हीकृष्णन ने प्लांटेशन कॉरपोरेशन ऑफ केरल की एक याचिका पर यह आदेश पारित किया, जिसमें अतिक्रमणकारियों को उसकी संपत्ति से बेदखल करने के लिए कदम उठाने की मांग की गई थी। माननीय न्यायालय ने मुख्य सचिव को निर्देश दिया कि वे सभी जिला कलेक्टरों को छह महीने के भीतर ऐसे "धार्मिक अतिक्रमणों" की पहचान करने के लिए राजस्व अधिकारियों और अन्य लोगों के माध्यम से जांच करने का निर्देश दें। माननीय न्यायाधीश ने कहा, "यदि लोग सार्वजनिक स्थानों और सरकारी भूमि पर अवैध धार्मिक संरचनाओं का निर्माण करना शुरू कर देंगे, तो इससे सांप्रदायिक वैमनस्य पैदा होगा। पीठ ने कहा, आस्तिक, चाहे वे किसी भी धर्म के हों, मानते हैं कि भगवान हर जगह हैं, उनके शरीर में, उनके घरों में और जहां भी वे जाते हैं। इसलिए, उन्हें धार्मिक संरचनाओं के निर्माण के लिए सरकारी भूमि पर अतिक्रमण करने की आवश्यकता नहीं है। पीठ ने यह भी कहा, "इसे भूमिहीन लोगों को वितरित किया जाए और मानव जाति के लिए इस्तेमाल किया जाए। ऐसी स्थिति में भगवान अधिक प्रसन्न होंगे और सभी विश्वासियों पर आशीर्वाद बरसाएंगे।

## 3500 रुपए में ओबीसी का फर्जी सर्टिफिकेट

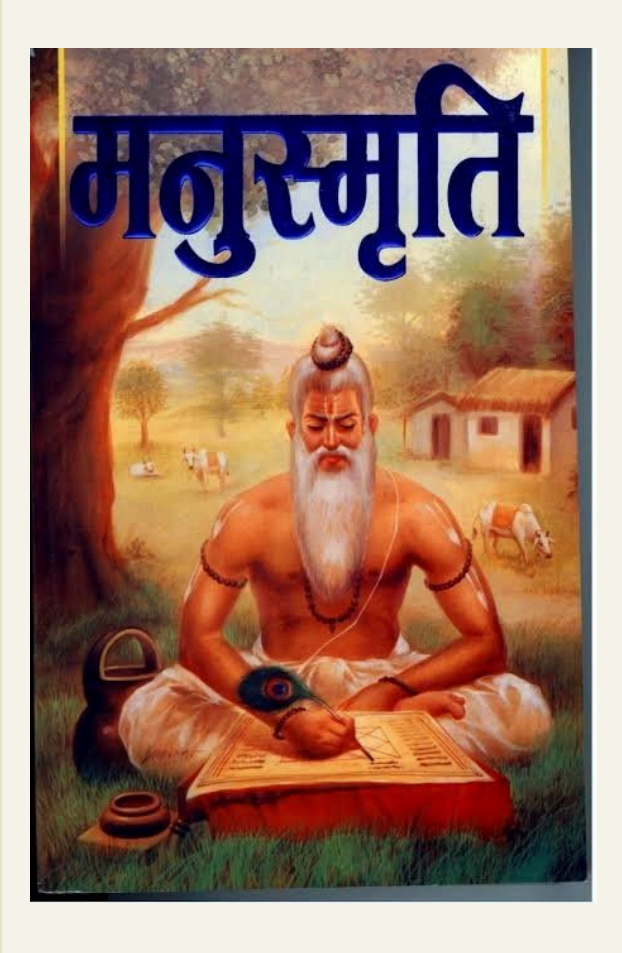

However, the real value of \$322 in terms of purchasing power parity comes to around Rs 10,000, In 2023, official reports said 94 per cent of the 8.4 crore unorganized-sector workers registered with the Union labour ministry’s E-Shram portal had declared they earned less than Rs 10,000 a month. According to Prof Arun Kumar of Jawaharlal Nehru University, “I would consider 90 per cent of the 30 crore workers registered now to be earning less than Rs 10,000 a month.”

## Canada says India second-biggest foreign threat to its democracy

These include Sinosteel, Shougang International, Baoshan Iron & Steel Ltd, Sany Heavy Industry Ltd, Chongqing Lifan Industry Ltd, China Dongfang International, Sino Hydro Corporation, etc. Many Chinese electronic, IT and hardware manufacturing companies are also having operations in India. These include Huawei Technologies, ZTE, TCL, Haier etc. A large number of Chinese companies are involved in EPC projects in the Power Sector.

These include Shanghai Electric, Harbin Electric, Dongfang Electric, Shenyang Electric etc. In recent years, Chinese mobile companies have achieved remarkable growth in India, with companies like Xiaomi, Huawei, Vivo and Oppo occupying over 80% of Indian mobile handset market. China`s exports to India of pharmaceutical -related goods are rising. From 2015 to 2022, India-China bilateral trade grew by 90.14%, an average yearly growth of 12.87%. In 2022, the overall trade with China increased by 8.47% year on year to reach USD 136.26 billion, crossing the USD 100 billion mark for a second time in a row. ## Hardeep Singh Nijjar murder in Canada vs India-Canada relations

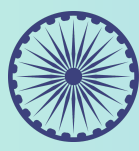

# BUDDHISM

## Why did Buddhism spread around the world?

- First, it offered a universalist message: that every individual could attain enlightenment by following its teachings. This message appealed to those, like women and peasants, who were marginalized in society.
- Second, Buddhism was missionary and had several powerful political supporters. Buddhists believed that their message could and should be spread to everyone and anyone. Emperor Ashoka was the first ruler to encourage Buddhist missionaries to travel abroad, and later Chinese rulers sought to spread Buddhism as a way to build their own power and influence.
- Finally, Buddhism was a flexible belief system, capable of adapting and changing to fit very different places and people.

Buddhists consider that their religion has Three Jewels\*: the Buddha, the Dhamma and the Sangha. They begin any ritual or religious ceremony by saying three times that they 'take refuge' in these Three Jewels, which are therefore also called the Three Refuges. Indeed, the taking of the Refuges is what defines a Buddhist. When they take refuge in the Buddha, Buddhists are thinking first and foremost of Gotama Buddha. Buddha is a title, meaning 'Enlightened' or 'Awakened'. Gotama was the family name of a man who was born on the Nepalese side of the modern Indian-Nepali border, early in the fifth century BCE, and died at the age of 80. According to later tradition, his personal name was Siddhartha. At the age of 35 he attained Enlightenment by realizing the Truth, the Dhamma.

### Tipitaka

In Pali it is called the Tipit.aka, which means that it consists of 'three baskets', i.e. three collections of texts: the Vinaya Pit.aka, which contains the vinaya, i.e. the rules or 'discipline' of the Sangha; the Sutta Pit.aka, which contains the Buddha's sermons and some religious poetry and other miscellaneous texts – this is far the largest 'basket'; and the Abhidhamma Pit.aka, which contains what is sometimes called 'systematic philosophy', a scholastic elaboration of doctrine, especially as regards the analysis of mind.

### Diligence

The King of Kosala is said: to have asked the Buddha one day whether there was one thing which could accomplish the ends of both this world and the next. Yes, said the Buddha: diligence. Diligence can win you longevity, health, beauty, heaven, birth in a good family and pleasures of the senses. (Richard F. Gombrich (1980). A Social History from ancient Benares to Modern Colombo, Routledge, New York, p.80.

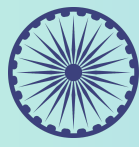

Much of the credit for the revival of Buddhism in India goes to Dr Ambedkar. Buddhism from becoming a sect of Hinduism in times of Shankaracharya became a mainstream religion because of efforts of Babasaheb. In his biography Babasaheb mentioned about his hardships and his fight towards the cause to make the Dalits get their identity. Dr. B.R. Ambedkar, often referred to as Babasaheb, is celebrated for his instrumental role in shaping modern India, especially through his work as the principal architect of the Indian Constitution. However, his journey towards Buddhism and his thoughts on the religion are equally significant, reflecting his profound quest for social justice and personal liberation. Born into the Mahar caste, considered untouchable in the rigid hierarchy of the Hindu caste system, Dr. Ambedkar faced severe discrimination and hardship from an early age.

He argued that the caste system was not a perversion of Hinduism but a fundamental aspect of it. His seminal works, such as "Annihilation of Caste," critiqued the religious and social structures that perpetuated discrimination and advocated for the total eradication of the caste system. 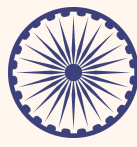

On October 14, 1956, in a historic ceremony in Nagpur, Dr. Ambedkar publicly converted to Buddhism along with approximately 500,000 of his followers. This mass conversion was not merely a religious act but a socio-political statement against caste oppression and a step towards reclaiming dignity and equality for Dalits. During the ceremony, Dr. Ambedkar took the "Three Refuges" and the "Five Precepts," marking his formal acceptance of Buddhism. Dr. Ambedkar also administered these vows to his followers, initiating a movement that significantly altered the religious landscape of India. This event is celebrated as "Dhammachakra Pravartan Din" (The Day of Conversion to Buddhism) by his followers and continues to inspire all. Dr. Ambedkar's adoption of Buddhism was a radical redefinition of the religion to suit the contemporary context of social equality and justice. He advocated for a "Navayana" or "New Vehicle" Buddhism, which rejected traditional rituals and dogmas and focused on the core teachings of the Buddha that emphasized emancipation from suffering and oppression. Babasaheb Ambedkar's journey towards Buddhism was a testament to his unwavering commitment to human dignity, social justice, and equality. His conversion was not only a personal spiritual journey but also a revolutionary act that sought to uplift millions of oppressed individuals in India. Dr. Ambedkar's thoughts on Buddhism continue to inspire and guide those who seek to challenge social injustices and work towards a more equitable world. His legacy as a Buddhist reformer and a champion of the downtrodden remains a beacon of hope and transformation.

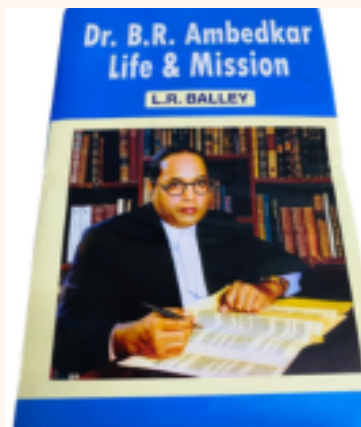
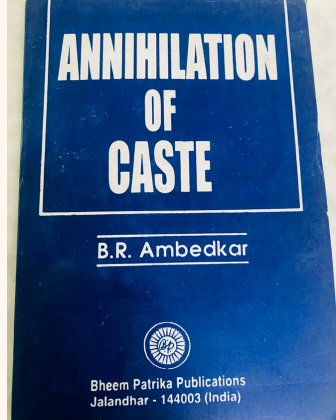
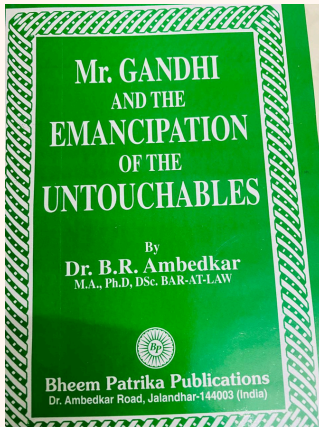
